

WATER SERVICE LINE INVENTORY



As you may know, your public water system is working to complete an inventory of all water service lines. This is a federal mandate being administered at the state level by the Minnesota Department of Health (MDH). Public water systems are required to notify all customers with service lines that have been classified as lead, galvanized, or unknown. The official notification is enclosed.

What is a service line?

A service line is the pipe connecting the water main to the interior plumbing in a building.

How is a service line classified?

Although some portion of the service pipe may have been identified as non-lead, until the entire length of the pipe can be verified, it must be classified as described in the link below.

Service Line Classification Determination: Systems with Shared Ownership (bit.ly/4dJ6GfO)

This means your service line may have been identified as non-lead in the building, but another portion was identified as lead, galvanized, or unknown. Therefore a notification is required.
